

CPR and First Aid Training Approval

Organizations that provide CPR and First Aid training are approved directly through the Department of Human Services.

Please note that CPR and First Aid training is not approved through the Growing Futures system, does not appear on the Growing Futures online training calendar, and is not automatically included on individual training records. Individuals who wish to have this information included on their training record may send photocopies of their CPR/First Aid cards to the Registry to be manually entered on their record. However, individuals are responsible to maintain their own documentation of current CPR/First Aid qualifications and to provide it at license renewal.
